BIO-FUELS CO-PRODUCTS TASKFORCE – Ali Kashani (WA) Chair

AAFCO Board of Directors, on June 3, 2008, instructed formation of a taskforce to develop educational materials to distribute to bio-fuel manufacturers, state agencies and the feed industry concerning existing rules and regulations that apply to co-products from bio-fuel production intended for use as feed or feed ingredient. On August 4, 2008 (from 9:25 – 10:15), the Bio-fuels Co-products taskforce held a brief meeting in Nashville, Tennessee. Names of members and advisors of the taskforce were collected and suggestions provided by the attendees were discussed. The details of the issues discussed are in the minutes of the meeting posted on the AAFCO Website.

A draft educational document was developed and distributed to the members and advisors and other interested parties prior to the AAFCO Midyear meeting. The taskforce held a meeting at the Midyear meeting in Tucson, Arizona. Kent Kitade of California Department of Food and Agriculture chaired the meeting and among other issues discussed the content of the document. Minutes of the meeting was distributed and is available at the AAFCO Website. A second version of the educational document was distributed for review and comments on June 12, 2009. A meeting has been scheduled for further discussion of the educational material at the annual meeting on August 3rd in Washington, DC.
