Sample 2007-22, due March 10th 2007

Due to the high fiber content of this sample, grinding causes clumping and there is a tendency for the fiber clumps to segregate. This segregation is likely during shipment of the sample. This sample will be documented as a non-homogeneous sample. There is nothing that AAFCO can do to alleviate this problem. We do not recommend further grinding; the sample should be tested as-is.
