Recommendations for Hands-on Training Stations for the demonstration of proper feed sampling techniques.

1. Bagged feed station
 - Demonstration of the *Single Tube Trier* and the *West Virginia Trier*
 - A station with 2 pallets of bagged feed (1 textured feed and 1 finely ground meal)
2. Liquid feed station
 - Demonstration of the *Liquid Bomb Sampler*, *Liquid Zone Sampler* and the *Texas Molasses Sampler*
 - A station set up with liquid molasses feed (water can be substituted).
3. Bulk feed station
 - Demonstration of the sampling pattern using the *Missouri D Probe* and the *7 Foot Closed Compartment Probe*.
 - A station set up with feed in a bulk delivery truck and / or bulk bin storage.
4. Block feed station
 - Demonstration of the tools recently researched by the Feed & Mineral Block Sampling Task Force.
 - A station with 4 – 6 feed blocks.
5. Feed processing station
 - Demonstration of the Stream Sampling Cup
 - A station where feed can be accessed from a conveyor.
6. Tour of feed facilities – A tour or presentation where a feed mill representative would explain the process of formulating, mixing and building a feed or ration. The tour would ideally include the mixing operation and an explanation on the intricacies of assuring that premixes are well dispersed with a feed.
