What are VFDs

- Medically Important Antibiotics
- ♦ Require Orders from A Veterinarian
- Must Be Fed According to Orders
- Require Additional Documentation
 - ♦ VCPR
 - Expiration Date
 - ♦ 2 years

History

- ♦ Initial VFD Rule 1996
 - ♦ Combat Increasing Antibiotic Resistance
 - ♦ Protect Human and Animal Health
 - ♦ Transition from Over the Counter
- ♦ Revisions for 2017
 - ♦ Responsibility of Veterinarians
 - Appropriate Drug
 - ♦ Dose
 - ♦ Duration

VFD Changes

- ♦ Removal of Production Uses
 - ♦ Growth Promotion
 - ♦ Feed Efficiency
- ♦ Treatment and Prevention
 - ♦ Beef Cattle Example
 - ♦ Treatment and Prevention of Anaplasmosis
 - Changed from Improved Rate of Gain
 - ♦ Most Notably in Tennessee
 - ♦ Pinkeye Salt

Regulatory Changes

- ♦ Label Review
 - ♦ Stop Sales
- ♦ January 1, 2017
 - ♦ Feed Mill Changes
 - ♦ No Medications
 - ♦ Feed Mill Inventory Reduction
- Decreased Inventory
 - ♦ Less Feed Mills = Less Feed
 - Order Status and Delivery
 - ♦ Limited Availability

Laboratory Changes

- ♦ Limited Feed Availability
 - ♦ Limited Samples
- Program Samples and Registered Products
 - ♦ Monthly Samples Prior to 2017
 - ♦ 2017 O samples of CTC
 - ♦ 2018/2019 28 Samples of CTC
 - ♦ Currently 56 Samples of CTC
- Production and Usage Scheduling
