## **Label Comparisons**

**New Formatting** – Updated to more closely resemble human food labeling to enhance transparency and consumer understanding

**Calorie Distribution Changes** – Calorie content is broken down into calories from protein, fat, and carbohydrate. To achieve or maintain a healthy body weight for your pet, it is important to understand the total number of calories, or "energy", your pet gets from all sources (protein, fat, fiber, and carbohydrate) in a serving of food.

**New Nutrients Per Cup** – Nutrients are guaranteed using common household measurements, like 8 oz measuring cup, weight in grams (one ounce is about 30 grams), or per can, pouch, or other easily defined amounts.

**Guarantee Changes** – Total carbohydrate and dietary fiber guarantees replace the crude fiber guarantee. Dietary fiber is a better measure of fiber.

**Nutritional Adequacy Statement Placement** – Required to appear at the bottom of the Pet Nutrition Facts box for consistency across all products.
